

Guidelines for Preparing Poster

Poster session is an important technical session in 7th Libyancorr. Due to shortage of time many good papers have been selected for poster presentation.

Posters are a special type of presentation. Scientific posters are a good way to disseminate the results of a research project without having to give an oral presentation. They can be printed out on one large sheet of paper with a special printer or made of several smaller pieces of paper hung together on a large sheet. 42 x 48 inches space will be provided for each poster. Therefore, it is strongly recommended to prepare your poster considering the size of the allocated space.

When making your poster keep in mind that people will want to read your poster from a distance and take away points as quickly as possible. The size of fonts of your poster presentation should be selected in such a way that they can be readable from 10 to 15 feet distance. Always make the words on your poster easy to read from a distance, especially your title. Also, do not include a lot of words on your poster. Make your sentences brief and to the point. Use graphs that are large and easy to read and that can stand alone without a long figure legend. You are more likely to attract people to your poster if it appears neat and is easy to read. Finally, include your contact information on the poster in case someone wishes to speak with you further regarding your research.
